South suburban residents! Apply for the “Residential Weatherization Program,” Funded by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Attend this open enrollment hosted by Diversified Alliances Inc. to submit an application. Weatherization services are made available in your community, through the Urban Weatherization Initiative (UWI). This valuable program is designed to increase energy savings in low-income households located in areas with high rates of unemployment, underemployment and poverty. Eligible applicants will receive a complete assessment of current energy usage, energy efficiency solutions, retrofit design and installation.

Eligibility requirements:

▪ Household Family size/ Income limits

- 1 Person \$30,420
- 2 Person \$34,800
- 3 Person \$39,120
- 4 Person \$43,440

For each additional family member add: \$3,480

Documentation Requirements:

- Proof of income for past 3 months
- Verification of resident as Owner/mortgage or Tenant/executed lease

NOTE: No household may be denied the right to apply for Weatherization assistance. Assistance is available to Spanish speaking, hearing, vision or speech impaired and literacy challenged applicants, including a home visit. Properties may not exceed six (6) units. Properties up for sale, foreclosures and previously weatherized through the Urban Weatherization Initiative are ineligible. Contact: V. Felix (708-629-0607)
