APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO BARRICADE A PUBLIC STREET FOR A "BLOCK PARTY"

Sec. 25-20. Code of Ordinances.

A permit MAY be issued to barricade a public street for the purpose of conducting a "Block Party", which is intended for the benefit of the "neighboring residents", provided such barricades will impose no undue interference upon traffic flow.

A "BLOCK PARTY" as it pertains to this ordinance is a festive community gathering that is held outdoors for all people who live in the neighborhood or within a specific area or block, which is typically held on a closed-off area of a street.

The applicant shall be an adult resident of the affected street and must obtain prior endorsement and participation from the neighbors affected, that is, RESIDENTS OF EVERY HOUSEHOLD ON THE STREET TO BE BLOCKED MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE DATE AND TIMES OF THE BLOCK PARTY. APPROVAL OF THE STREET BLOCKAGE OR AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARTY MUST BE OBTAINED FROM A MINIMUM OF 90% OF ALL RESIDENTS OF THE STREET TO BE BLOCKED BEFORE THE PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED. RESIDENTS CAN PICK-UP AN ADDITIONAL FORM FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAINING RESIDENT SIGNATURES IN APPROVAL OF YOUR BLOCK PARTY AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OR IN THE DOCUMENT CENTER AT VILLAGEOFPARKFOREST.COM UNDER POLICE.

If a permit is granted for a "Block Party", the recipients must conform to all ordinances of the Village of Park Forest, particularly with respect to littering of the streets and disturbance of the peace.
