The Park Forest Bark District is 3.5 acres, divided into two sections (small/large dogs), with 4 foot high fencing. The park features benches, a drinking fountain, and shade for yourself and your dog to utilize.

Fees / Required Vaccinations

Hours are from Sunrise to Sunset

Annual permit (12 months)

\$30/Park Forest Resident

\$40/Non-Resident

Key Card: You will be issued 1 key card. Replacement cards are \$10 if you lose or damage your card. Key cards can be renewed. Please return key card if you are not renewing your membership.

The Bark District Park is restricted to members only. In order to obtain a membership proof of vaccinations from a veterinarian will be required. Vaccinations must be kept current and a copy submitted to the Recreation & Parks Department. Dogs must display a current rabies tag. You must register each year with the Recreation & Parks Department and submit proof of vaccinations.

Rules

Failure to comply with these rules may result in revocation of your Bark District membership.

- ◆ Users of this facility do so at their own risk. The Village of Park Forest is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog or handler in the Bark District Park.
- ◆ The Bark District Park is restricted to members only. In order to obtain a membership proof of vaccinations will be required. Vaccinations must be kept current and a copy submitted to the Recreation & Parks Department. Dogs must display a current rabies tag.
- ◆ Do not allow anyone into the Bark District that does not have a key card. This is for you and your pet's safety. Encourage visitors to pick up a membership application at Village Hall. Report fence jumpers to the police.
- ◆ No firearms or weapons allowed in the Bark District Park.
- ◆ Member identification must be worn and visible.
- ◆ Only 2 dogs per person will be allowed in the park.
- ◆ Dogs must be accompanied by an adult 18 years and older at all times.
- ◆ Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and leaving the park. Owners must carry a leash at all times.
- ◆ Dogs who exhibit aggressive behavior should be removed immediately from the park to avoid the potential for injury to other dogs or handlers.
- ◆ Gates must be kept closed at all times.
- ◆ Do not bring an unhealthy dog into the park.
- ◆ Female dogs in heat are not permitted.
- ◆ No prong or pinch collars are allowed in the run area.
- ◆ Owners must clean up after their dog. Bags and waste receptacles will be available in the park.
- ◆ Please cover any holes your dog digs.
- ◆ No smoking, glass containers, food, alcohol or soft drinks are allowed in the park. This is to ensure the park stays clean and prevents dogs from begging for food or showing aggressive behavior. A water fountain is available for human and canine use.
- ◆ Please refrain from bringing dog treats/bones in as it can bring out aggressive behavior in dogs.
- ◆ We recommend keeping your dog on flea and tick treatment and heartworm preventative.
- ◆ The park may be closed periodically to allow turf to recover, especially after heavy rain or wintertime use.
- ◆ The Village of Park Forest reserves the right to suspend or revoke park privileges to any member who fails to follow park rules and etiquette or where the Village of Park Forest has determined a member dog or dog owner/handler is dangerous to others or is in violation of any applicable animal ordinances or regulations.
