Rent one of our super cookers when cooking for a crowd. Super cookers are available to rent for use at parks in Park Forest. The giant charcoal grill consists of a 2' x 5' cooking surface which is sure to handle the largest of group appetites. This unit will cook 50 hamburgers, 200 hot dogs or 30 steaks.



Reserving the Cooker

Rental Fee: \$60.00 per day

Super cookers can be delivered to pavilions at Central, Logan or Somonauk parks. No deliveries before 8:00 a.m. Self pick-up is not allowed.

You can reserve the cooker at the Department of Recreation, Parks & Community Health, 350 Victory Dr., Park Forest, IL 60466 (Village Hall).

An Equipment Permit is required and full payment is due at time of reservation. We accept cash, check, money order, Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express. Equipment Permits are subject to a 5% cancellation fee. A \$35 fee will be charged for returned checks or cancelled charges.

Super Cooker Preparation

If you are planning to utilize the entire cooking surface, approximately 1 large bag of charcoal will be required for a good coal bed. Make sure coals are good and hot before starting (approximately 45 minutes to one hour). The amount of coals that will be required varies according to the amount of meat and the number of times the cooker is opened. Cooking times will be less than on an open grill. Extra coals may be added by raising the cooking rack. Raise the cooking rack if the cooking temperature is too high.

Super Cooker Cleaning

Cooker must be cleaned after use. Metal grate should be cleaned with a stiff wire brush. Hot coals must be extinguished before placing them in designated containers.
