



**BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS
IF YOU ARE REMOVING AN INTERIOR WALL
OR CREATING AN INTERIOR "PASS THROUGH" WALL**



Provide "EXISTING" and "PROPOSED" layouts of footprint of home. Indicate direction of roof rafters.



Example: Non-load bearing interior wall

Provide drawings of work to be done.

- For non-load bearing interior walls, construction drawings will be accepted.
- For load-bearing interior walls, stamped drawings from a design professional (structural engineer or architect) are required.

PROVIDE the following information:

LENGTH/WIDTH of newly created opening: _____

HEADERS:

Will be double 2 x 12's on edge

PLATES:

There will be single 2 x _____'s continuous sill plate
There will be double 2 x _____'s continuous top plates

STUDDING:

There will be 2 x _____'s or 4 x _____'s
spaced not more than _____ inches on center

Will any electric be removed? Relocated?
If so, provide additional information.

A building permit is required for this type of construction. To apply, provide: building permit application, proposal from licensed contractor (or homeowner waiver), required drawings, permit fee.

Permit Fee:

<u>Valuation of Work</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Less than \$250	No fee, permit required
\$250 to \$1500	\$60.00
\$1051 to \$2000	\$100.00
\$2001 and above	\$100.00 plus \$10 per \$1000 on valuations over \$2001
